

ICE Liaison: your job

- **BEFORE ANYTHING HAPPENS:
BE READY TO VIDEO ICE EVENTS**

Make sure someone is ready every day. This could be you or someone else. Record video from a safe distance. Do not interfere with ICE operations. Get video of the whole event including ICE agents, vehicles and license plates.



- **WHEN ICE IS SPOTTED:
CALMLY MOVE STAFF INTO PRIVATE
AREAS AND CLOSE THE DOORS.**

ICE is **allowed** to enter **public areas** of a workplace. Public areas include places like the dining area of a restaurant or an office lobby.

ICE is **NOT allowed** to enter **private areas**.

Private areas include kitchens or private offices — any place the public does not enter.



- **ASK TO SEE A
JUDICIAL WARRANT**

- **MAKE SURE THE WARRANT
IS CORRECT**

The warrant must have ALL THREE of these items to be a Judicial Warrant.

If they show any **other** kind of warrant, or if they have **no** warrant, tell ICE they **cannot** enter private areas.



1 Comes from a COURT

2 Shows your correct name or address

3 Signed by a JUDGE

Unless delayed notice is authorized by law, I will give a copy of the warrant and a receipt for the property taken to the person from whom, or from whom the property was taken, or leave the copy and receipt at the place where the property was taken.
The officer executing this warrant, or an officer accompanying the officer in the execution of the warrant, must prepare an inventory as required by law and promptly return the property to the person to whom it belongs or to United States Magistrate Judge Duty Magistrate (name)
 I find that immediate notification may have an adverse effect on the investigation and, therefore, I waive U.S.C. § 2705 (except for delay of trial), and authorize the officer executing this warrant to seize any property, including the property to be searched or seized (check the appropriate box) for 30 days from the date of execution of the warrant to a specific date of July 23, 2013.

- **IF THE WARRANT LOOKS REAL,
SEND A PHOTO TO A LAWYER**

Take a photo and send it to a lawyer for confirmation before admitting ICE. If the lawyer says it is valid, you must let them in.

Guide to shooting video

- **DO NOT INTERFERE** with ICE operations.
- **VIDEO FROM A SAFE DISTANCE**
- **RECORD AGENTS, CARS, LICENSE PLATES**
- **SEND THE VIDEO**
to the lawyer
to your local immigrant support organization.
Do NOT post on social media.
